

CONSENT TO PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

I, the subject of personal data, in accordance with Federal Law No. 152-FZ “On Personal Data”, of my free will and for own benefits, give my consent to personal data processing to PJSC “Biosintez”, located at: 4 Druzhby str., 440013, Penza, the Penza region, (hereinafter referred to as the Operator), subject to the following conditions:

1. This Consent is provided to process my personal data both using and without the use of automation tools.
2. The Consent is provided to process my following personal data: last name, first name, patronymic; date of birth; contact phone number; e-mail address; information about labor activity (working period, name of companies, main activity, position, duties); information about knowledge of foreign languages (names of languages and proficiency); information about education, qualifications, specialty, retraining; name and details (series and number, date of issue, name of the issuing authority) of certificate of education, qualifications, specialty; information about special skills; information about interests; other data specified in my CV; actual residential address.
3. Purpose of personal data processing: **search, selection and interviewing of candidates to fill vacancies of the Operator, verification of a candidate for a vacant position.**
4. While processing, the following operation with the personal data will be performed: collection, recording, systematization, accumulation, storage, clarification (updating, changing), retrieval, use, transfer (provision, access), blocking, deletion, destruction.
5. Personal data is processed until a decision on the employment of the candidate or withdrawal of the Consent to personal data processing, whichever occurs first.
6. The Consent may be withdrawn by the subject of personal data or his/her representative by applying a request to the Operator at Biosintez.Info@sunpharma.com.
7. When the subject of personal data or his/her representative withdraws the consent to personal data processing, the Operator is entitled to continue processing personal data without the consent of the subject of personal data if eligible as per para. 2 - 11, part 1, Art. 6 of Federal Law No. 152-FZ "On personal data".
8. This Consent is valid until the termination of the processing of personal data specified in cl. 2 of this Consent.
